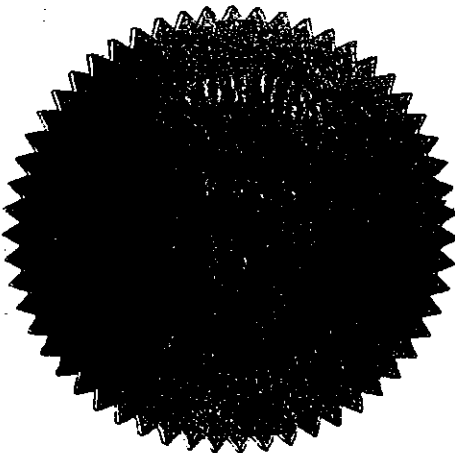

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

THE NEW MEXICO FOUNDATION FOR OPEN GOVERNMENT, INC.

The undersigned acting as incorporators of a corporation under the New Mexico Nonprofit Corporation Act (Section 53-8-1 to 53-8-99 NMSA 1978), adopts the following Articles of Incorporation for such corporation:

I

The name of the corporation is THE NEW MEXICO FOUNDATION FOR OPEN GOVERNMENT, INC.

II

The period of its duration is perpetual.

III

The corporation is organized to conduct any and all lawful business for which corporations may be incorporated under the New Mexico Nonprofit Corporation Act; to conduct its business, carry on its operations, have offices and exercise the powers granted by the Nonprofit Corporation Act within or without this state, and to have and exercise all powers necessary or convenient to effect its purposes as further stated in the By-Laws.

The purposes of this corporation shall be carried out by:

- A. Encouraging, sponsoring, and facilitating the public's right to know about the workings of government at all levels;
- B. Encouraging, sponsoring, and facilitating the cultivation and diffusion of knowledge and understanding of the various civil liberties, First Amendment of the Constitution of the United States, and laws of the United States or of the State of New Mexico or which are established by traditions, through the giving of lectures and the publication of addresses, essays, treatises, reports and other literary and research works

in the field of press freedoms and First Amendment protections;

- C. Making inquiry into the extent and adequacy of the protection of freedoms in the United States and of the State of New Mexico, and to publish the results of any such inquiry;
- D. To supply assistance whenever possible to persons involved in activities wherein their First Amendment freedoms as guaranteed to them under the laws of the United States and of the State of New Mexico, are threatened or infringed upon.
